THE HISTORY BOYS

THURSDAY 10th FEBRUARY 2011 7.30 pm – HIS MAJESTY’S THEATRE

One of the great plays of the decade, The History Boys is set in a school in the North of England where a boisterous bunch of bright, funny sixth-form boys are attempting to gain entrance to Oxford and Cambridge whilst fending off the distractions of sport and sex. In Alan Bennett's much-loved play, staffroom battles and the anarchy of adolescence provide a rich vein of comedy.

The History Boys opened in May 2004 at the National Theatre to rave reviews and a sell-out run and went on to become one of their biggest ever hits, winning no less than 30 major awards including both Oliver and Tony Awards for Best New Play. In 2005, a film was made with the entire original cast, many of whom have subsequently become household names. This will be the first major revival of the play since the original National Theatre production.

Seats in the Dress Circle have been reserved and the tickets are on offer to Society members, spouses, partners and guests, ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS, at a price of **£19.50** each. To start the evening off appropriately, a pre-theatre dinner with drinks will be organised for 5.30pm at Carmine's (situated at 32 Union Terrace, directly across from HMT), which it is hoped most people will attend.
